The Hunger Games

Cast: Jennifer Lawrence, Josh Hutcherson, Liam Hemsworth, Elizabeth Banks

Rated: PG-13 for intense thematic violent material and disturbing images -- all involving teens

Story type: Action/Adventure, Adaptation, Sci-Fi/Fantasy

Run time: 142 min

Synopsis: Every year in the ruins of what was once North America, the nation of Panem forces each of its twelve districts to send a teenage boy and girl to compete in the Hunger Games. Part twisted entertainment, part government intimidation tactic, the Hunger Games are a nationally televised event in which "Tributes" must fight with one another until one survivor remains. Pitted against highly-trained Tributes who have prepared for these Games their entire lives, Katniss is forced to rely upon her sharp instincts as well as the mentorship of drunken former victor Haymitch Abernathy. If she's ever to return home to District 12, Katniss must make impossible choices in the arena that weigh survival against humanity and life against love.

Rated: R for crude and sexual content throughout, nudity, language, brief drug use and teen drinking

Story type: Comedy, Sequel

Run time: 113 min

Synopsis: It was summer 1999 when four small-town Michigan boys began a quest to lose their virginity. In the years that have passed, Jim and Michelle married while Kevin and Vicky said goodbye. Oz and Heather grew apart, but Finch still longs for Stifler's mom. Now these lifelong friends have come home as adults to reminisce about -- and get inspired by -- the hormonal teens they once were.

The Cabin in the Woods

Rated: R for strong bloody horror violence and gore, language, drug use and some sexuality/nudity

Story type: Horror, Thriller, Comedy

Run time: 95 min

Synopsis: Five friends go for a break at a remote cabin in the woods, where they get more than they bargained for. Together, they must discover the truth behind the cabin in the woods.

Lockout

Cast: Guy Pearce, Maggie Grace, Vincent Regan, Joseph Gilgun, Lennie James

Rated: PG-13 for intense sequences of violence and action, and language including some sexual references

Story type: Thriller, Sci-Fi/Fantasy, Action/Adventure

Run time: 95 min

Synopsis: On an orbiting prison 50 miles above the earth where the world's most dangerous criminals are kept asleep, the

prisoners are suddenly awakened, causing a panic. Only a wrongly-convicted government agent can rescue the President's daughter from the deep space prison riot.
