- Acts as a single point of contact within the command at each military installation.
- Provides information and explanation of available veterans' and retirees' entitlements, benefits, and resources.
- Refers to available civilian programs and services when military or veterans' resources cannot provide assistance.
- Works to protect your privacy, promote your well-being, and advocate for you.
- Publishes a newsletter regularly throughout the year and mails it out to approximately 5000 area retirees and surviving family members.
- Plans and hosts a semi-annual Retiree Open House that showcases services available aboard the base, as well as providing information and discounts on some services and products.
